


JOB POSTINGS BY MONTH FOR SIMCOE COUNTY

How many job postings were active for at least 1 day this month?









POST DATE TIMELINE FOR THIS MONTH'S ACTIVE JOB POSTINGS

DEMAND BY KEY SECTOR FOR SIMCOE COUNTY











DEMAND BY IMPACTED SECTOR FOR SIMCOE COUNTY







Full-time vs Part-time




JOB DURATION

Permanency of jobs posted














JOB POSTINGS BY JOB BOARD
